

In response to concerns of University Heights residents regarding speeding in our neighborhoods, the UHPD has acquired a portable speed trailer that is making appearances in various parts of town.

The speed trailer displays a vehicle's speed and increases driver awareness of our speed limits to reduce careless driving in our neighborhoods. It provides immediate feedback, doesn't require the presence of a police officer, and can be moved around. Additionally, the traffic data collection software provides valuable information such as total number of vehicles using our streets as well as median, maximum, and average vehicle speeds. This information assists the UHPD in identifying areas that require additional attention.

In University Heights, the speed limit on Melrose Avenue and on Sunset Street is 25mph; on non-arterial streets it is 20mph or lower to help keep our children, pedestrians, and cyclists safe.
