

## **June 2010 Mayor Report**

**May TTAC Meeting-** FY 11/12 work programs /transit projects/ funding projects were recommended to JCCOG Urbanized Area Policy Board. No projects were submitted for University Heights. I gave a report to the committee about the Melrose Ave. wide sidewalk project in University Heights.

### **May JCCOG Urbanized Area Policy Board Meeting- Highlights:**

2010 Trail Maps were passed out to the cities. Maps are available at the city office.

FY 11/12 projects were approved as recommended from TTAC.

The Board requested a subcommittee be formed to consider how Johnson County communities fund the East Central Iowa Council of Governments. Discuss and recommend to the Board how to appoint reps to the ECICOG Board of Directors.

Discuss and review JCCOG By-Laws, etc. I am serving on this sub committee.

I attended the first sub committee meeting on June 7<sup>th</sup>.

**May Emergency Management Meeting-** The Johnson County Joint Emergency Communication Center is on schedule to begin on July 1, 2010.

**JCCOG Traffic Report-**Traffic speed and volume data results on area around (North) Sunset St./Grand Ave/Golfview. I have copies of the report for the meeting.

I requested this report about a year ago after residents on Grand Ave. had complained about rush hour traffic using Grand Ave. as a "cut-through".

I have also requested traffic counts on Olive & Leamer as well as Traffic counts on Oakcrest/Koser area before and after additions to Horn School.

**June 2<sup>nd</sup>**-Groundbreaking Ceremony of \$27 Million –I-JOBS money for Flood Projects along the First Avenue Corridor in Coralville. Pat Yeggy and I attended representing the City of University Heights.

**June 3<sup>rd</sup>**- Received correspondence from Mid American Energy- they will be doing tree trimming service in University Heights starting this month to insure safe and reliable electric service. They will be sending out letters to all affected properties 14 days before and then a phone call two days before. Immediately before work begins, crew will knock on the door of the affected property and explain what work is needed. I will give the correspondence to Mike Haverkamp to post on the city website.

### **City Stationery and 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary T-Shirts.**

I received final paperwork from Ericka Shultz on Olive Ct. today.

You may remember Amy Moore presented to council some of her work several months ago and council agreed to ordering stationery, envelopes and t-shirts. (CD's of all the logos, etc. is included)
