Mayor Louise From called the April 23, 2013, special council meeting of the University Heights City Council to order at 5:30 p.m.

Chairperson Rettig called the Johnson County Board of Supervisors special meeting to order at 5:31 p.m.

Mayor From thanked the University Club for providing the meeting space. Introductions were made of all council members, supervisors, staff and public.
