RESOLUTION NO. 14-22

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING A REVENUE PURPOSE STATEMENT FOR THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS REGARDING THE LOCAL OPTION SALES AND SERVICE TAX THAT WILL APPEAR ON THE NOVEMBER 4, 2014, GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT**

**WHEREAS**, the Local Option Sales and Service Tax (LOSST) will appear as a public measure on the General Election Ballot November 4, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the University Heights City Council has the authority to adopt a Revenue Purpose Statement indicating how any LOSST revenues received by the City would be allocated, assuming the LOSST measure is adopted; and

**WHEREAS**, the Johnson County Board of Supervisors initially requested that municipalities in the County specify that 10% of LOSST revenues received by each municipality be allocated for repayment of debt associated with the Johnson County Courthouse Annex proposal, which is also on the General Election Ballot; and

**WHEREAS**, the University Heights City Council adopted a Revenue Purpose Statement at its meeting August 12, 2014, allocating 10% to the Courthouse Annex Proposal as requested (Resolution No. 12-21); and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors later withdrew its request that LOSST revenues be allocated for this purpose,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of University Heights, Iowa, adopts and approves the following ballot language regarding the Local Option Sales and Service Tax that will appear on the November 4, 2014, General Election Ballot, and hereby requests that the Johnson County Auditor include this language on the ballot:

SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

A local sales and services tax shall be imposed in the City of University Heights at the rate of one percent (1%) to be effective from July 1, 2015, until June 30, 2025. Revenues from the sales and services tax shall be allocated as follows:

0% for property tax relief

The specific purpose for which the revenues shall otherwise be expended is:

100% for community space acquisition, furnishing, maintenance, and upkeep; street improvements and repairs; and/or any other lawful purpose.
