RESOLUTION NO. 19-09

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE HIRING OF TROY A. KELSAY TO SERVE AS CHIEF OF POLICE FOR THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS, WITH EMPLOYMENT DETAILS TO BE APPROVED BY FURTHER RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, University Heights Police Chief Nate Petersen tendered his resignation effective April 12, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City of University Heights, Iowa, posted the Police Chief job opening as required by law, and sought applicants to fill the position; and

WHEREAS, a Committee comprising the Mayor, Community Protection Committee members, and City Attorney (as a consulting member but not a voting member) interviewed applicants and unanimously recommends that Troy A. Kelsay be hired as Police Chief by the City of University Heights; and

WHEREAS, the Committee recommends that the Mayor, Community Protection Committee, and City Attorney make specific recommendations concerning Troy A. Kelsay's employment as Police Chief, including compensation and benefits, to be considered and, if acceptable to the City Council and Troy A. Kelsay, approved by further Resolution of the City Council authorizing the Mayor to sign a written employment agreement,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS, IOWA, AS FOLLOWS:

- A. Troy A. Kelsay is approved to be hired as Police Chief for the City of University Heights, Iowa.
- B. The Mayor, Community Protection Committee, and City Attorney are directed to make specific recommendations concerning Troy A. Kelsay's employment as Police Chief, including compensation and benefits, to be considered by the City Council in the form of a further Resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign a written employment agreement with Troy A. Kelsay.
- C. The City Council expects to appoint an Interim Police Chief to serve from the effective date of Chief Petersen's resignation (April 12, 2019) until the employment of a permanent Police Chief has been finalized.

RESOLUTION NO. 19-10

RESOLUTION APPOINTING DARRYL TUCKER AS INTERIM POLICE CHIEF FOR THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS

WHEREAS, University Heights Police Chief Nate Petersen tendered his resignation effective April 12, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of University Heights, Iowa, desires to appoint University Heights Police Officer Darryl Tucker Interim Police Chief effective April 12, 2019,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS, IOWA AS FOLLOWS:

- A. The City Council of the City of University Heights, Iowa hereby appoints Darryl Tucker as Interim Police Chief effective April 12, 2019, and continuing through the effective date of the City Council hiring a permanent Police Chief or otherwise terminates the appointment of the Interim Police Chief.
- B. The Interim Police Chief shall have all duties, obligations, powers, and authority of the Police Chief of the University Heights Police Department as provided by local, state, and federal law.
- C. The salary of the Interim Police Chief shall be \$69,888.00 effective April 12, 2019, and continuing through Darryl Tucker’s service as Interim Police Chief.
