Mayor From called the public hearing to consider the above mentioned 2006 improvement projects to order at 7:00 p.m. No representatives from the public sector were present to speak concerning these projects. The public hearing was adjourned at 7:02 p.m.

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS CITY COUNCIL

Mayor From called a special meeting of the Council to order at 7:03 p.m.

Present: Mayor From. Council Members Christine Anderson, Erling Anderson, Stan Laverman, Brennan McGrath and Patricia Yeggy. Staff present: Clerk Musser, Engineer Bilskemper, Attorney Ballard.

Engineer Bilskemper presented two bids received on the 2006 Street Improvements. The lower bid was from All American Concrete Inc. This bid met the approval of Engineer Bilskemper. **MOTION** McGrath, seconded by Laverman, to approve the bid of All American Concrete Inc. for the 2006 Street Improvement Project.

All voting AYE Carried

Bids on the 2006 Project for 2006 Sidewalk Improvements were then presented. One bid did not meet the technical specifications of the bid, therefore was rejected. The other bid was from All American Concrete Inc. **MOTION** by McGrath, seconded by Laverman, to approve the bid of All American Concrete Inc. for the 2006 Sidewalk Improvement Project.

All voting AYE Carried

There then was informal discussion by the Council again concerning vegetation at 36 Highland and other locations. This will again be an agenda item in September. Mayor From reminded the Council that the University Athletic Club representatives wanted discussion with all Council members. Engineer Bilskemper noted that the street striping project had not been completed, he had called the company and they were to finish the work before payment was completed. E. Anderson, JCCOG representative spoke of the considerable interest generated by the Forevergreen Road extension project, which is due for vote at the next JCCOG meeting.
