ORDINANCE NO. 33

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING CONDUCT IN THE TOWN OF UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS. IOWA

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS, IOWA:

Sec. 1. DISORDERLY CONDUCT. No person shall within the corporate limits of the Town of University Heights, Iowa, disturb the peace of any person or persons, or use, with intent to provoke a breach of peace, any unseemly profane, indecent, or obscene language, or with such intent make use of or be guilty of any violent or offensive conduct; and no person shall, with like intent, assault, beat or strike another, or allow any such language, conduct or behavior within or upon any house or premises owned by him or by him owned, occupied, or controlled, so that any person or persons in the vicinity of such premises are disturbed or annoyed thereby.

If any person within the corporate limits of this Town conducts himself in a lewd, indecent or immoral way or engages with another person or persons in any b0isterous, offensive, or disorderly conduct which is shocking or degrading to the public morals and decency, he shall be guilty of disorderly conduct.

Sec. 2. INTOXICATION. No person within the corporate limits of the Town of University Heights, Iowa, shall be found intoxicated upon any street, alley or public ground, or in any public place; nor shall any person drink any intoxicating liquor or beer in any street, alley or public place.

Sec. 3. PENALTY. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to imprisonment not exceeding 30 days, or a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars, or both.
