

ORDINANCE NO. 64

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE IMPOUNDING OF VEHICLES.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of University Heights, Iowa:

1. Any police officer or employee of the City designated to enforcing parking and traffic ordinances of the City on finding any vehicle unattended at a place where" the vehicle constitutes an obstruction to vehicular or pedestrian traffic may remove or cause the removal of such vehicle to a place designated by a peace officer [or storage of impounded vehicles. Upon impoundment of such vehicle, the City shall notify the last known registered owner of such impoundment by certified mail if the name and address of the owner can be ascertained with reasonable diligence. The registered owner or operator may reclaim such vehicle by payment o~ any charges for towing and storage, which payment shall be made to the facility where the vehicles is impounded.
2. Ordinance No.36 is hereby repealed when this ordinance becomes effective.
3. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
