

ORDINANCE NO. 67

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CURFEW FOR MINORS UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of University Heights, Iowa:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person under sixteen (16) years of age to be or remain in or upon any of the streets, alleys or public places in the city between the hours of 10:30 p.m. and 6:30 a.m., prevailing time, unless such person is accompanied by his or her parent, guardian, or other adult person having the custody of, or legally responsible for such minor person, or unless such person has a reasonable or legitimate reason for being upon such streets or alleys or at such public places within the specified hours.
2. It is hereby made unlawful for any parent, guardian or other person, responsible for the care and custody of any child under sixteen (16) years of age to allow or permit such child to be in or upon any of the streets, alleys, or other public places in the city within the times prohibited by this division, unless there exists a reasonable necessity therefor.
3. Violation of this ordinance shall constitute a simple misdemeanor.
3. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
