

ORDINANCE NO. 138

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 108
CONCERNING THE POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL BY MINORS.

I. Ordinance No. 108 is amended as follows:

Section 2. PENALTY.

- a. A person who is under the legal age, other than a licensee or permittee, who violates this section regarding the purchase of or attempt to purchase alcoholic liquor, wine, or beer, or possessing or having control of alcoholic liquor, wine, or beer, commits a simple misdemeanor punishable by a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for the first offense.
- b. A second or subsequent offense shall be a simple misdemeanor punishable by a fine of two hundred dollars (\$200.00). In determining if a violation is a second or subsequent offense for purposes of this ordinance, convictions under statutes or ordinances substantially corresponding to this ordinance shall be counted as previous offenses. Each previous conviction entered prior to the date of the violation charged shall be considered and counted as a separate previous offense.
- c. The sentence imposed under this section shall not be suspended or deferred by the court, nor shall judgment be deferred, notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 907 of the Code of Iowa, as amended, or any other provision of statute.

Section 3. REPEALER. All ordinances and parts of ordinances and conflicts with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

II. This amendment shall become effective upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
