

ORDINANCE NO. 170

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY CITY, SUBJECT TO THE CONSENT OF A MAJORITY OF THE UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS CITY COUNCIL, TO APPOINT A NON-POLICE OFFICER AS ADMINISTRATIVE POLICE CHIEF WITH DUTIES TO BE ESTABLISHED BY RESOLUTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS, JOHNSON COUNTY, IOWA:

The Mayor of the City of University Heights is hereby authorized, subject to the consent of a majority of the University Heights City Council, to appoint a non-police officer to serve as the University Heights Chief of Police, as an Administrative Chief. If the Mayor and the Council desire to avail themselves of the authority to appoint a non-police officer to serve as Administrative Police Chief, they may do so by making such appointment by resolution. If an Administrative Police Chief is appointed, the Council shall adopt duties for the Administrative Police Chief by resolution. After initial adoption, those duties may be amended or revised by subsequent resolution adopted by the Council.

SAVING CLAUSE.

In the event any word, phrase, sentence, paragraph or section contained in this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional for any reason, then it is hereby declared that the remaining such portions and provisions of this ordinance would have been enacted and remain in full force and effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication as provided by law.

REPEALER.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.




