Iowa Home Football Game Day Regulations Tailgate Responsibly in University Heights

- Do not let an arrest for public intoxication or drunk driving ruin your game day. Have your guests plan for a safe ride home before the game starts.
- Keep streets, sidewalks, and the right-of-way clear. Do not allow guests to congregate or set up chairs, tents, grills, games, or other items on the street, sidewalk, or the area between the street and sidewalk. Leave enough space in your yard to accommodate guests, activities, and equipment.
- Make sure your guests do not trespass on neighbors' property.
- Vehicles can only park on lawns on the day of the game and must be removed by midnight.
- All trash must be cleaned up and removed. Trash bags/carts must not be left at the curb after the game. Remove the trash yourself or require guests to haul their trash away.
- Keep music and all sound at a reasonable level. [Ordinance No. 159](#) is enforceable related to noise pollution, even on game day. No amplified music.
- Outdoor vending of merchandise is prohibited ([Ordinance No. 81](#)).
- Make sure your guests are considerate of neighbors and children. Curb inappropriate language and profanities.
- The use of fireworks is illegal in University Heights and has a minimum fine of \$250.
- Portable toilets that are visible from the street can only be put in place the Thursday before each Saturday game and must be removed by 5:00 p.m. the Sunday after the game (adjust days for non-Saturday games).
- Portable toilets that are adequately screened so they are not visible from the street may be put in place the Thursday before the first game and removed within 72 hours of the last game. Toilets must be cleaned by 5:00 p.m. the day after each game and they must be kept locked on non-game days.
- Golf carts must have University Heights permits through the University Heights Police Department.
- For game day issues, **get University Heights Police Department assistance by calling the Communications Center at 319-356-6800**. University Heights Police will triage responses. For emergencies, dial 911.
