WORK SESSION MEETING

Mayor From called the June 2, 2020 work session meeting of the University Heights City Council to order at 7:08 p.m.

Police Chief Troy Kelsay updated the council on the protest marches and vandalism that occurred in Iowa City and Coralville on June 1st.

Discussion on Council Goals: Karen Kurt, Executive Director for East Central Iowa Council of Governments (ECICOG) outlined the process for the council goal-setting session. As facilitator, Kurt’s role is to guide the council through the process.

Discussion topics included:

- Positive attributes of the city
- Projects in process
