ORDINANCE NO. 176

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 81 (REGULATING THE DISPLAY, SALE, AND DISTRIBUTION OF GOODS, MERCHANDISE, AND SERVICES).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS, JOHNSON COUNTY, IOWA:

University Heights Ordinance No. 81 is amended as follows (with additions indicated by underline and deletions indicated by strike-through):

* * * *

Section 6. ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES. Any violation of this code may be cited as a municipal infraction. The University Heights City Clerk, or the Clerk's duly authorized agent, and any officer, including reserve officers, of the University Heights Police Department are authorized to enforce this code and may issue a civil citation to anyone who violates any section or provision of this code. A violation of this code is punishable by a civil penalty of \$250.00 for a first offense and a civil penalty of \$500.00 for a repeat offense. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be quilty of a simple misdemeanor punishable by a fine of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00). The sentence imposed under this Section shall not be suspended or deferred by the court, nor shall judgment be deferred, notwithstanding the provisions of Ch. 907 of the Code of Iowa, as amended, or any other provision of statute.

* * * *

This amendment shall become effective upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
